### Employment Opportunity **SENIOR LEADER - SUMMER DAY CAMP**

Marpole-Oakridge Community Centre and the Marpole-Oakridge Community Association are seeking energetic individuals with strong leadership skills and past experience working with children's community centre camp programs to lead an outdoor/indoor based summer day camp for children 6–12-year olds.

In compliance with the Canada Summer Jobs program guidelines, all applicants must be able to work full-time (35-40 hours per week) during the project period; and complete a police record check upon hiring.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Have/pursuing an education in related field, such as education, recreation, CYCC, social services or a related discipline is preferred. A minimum completion of Grade 12 is required.
- Experience working with children in a recreational program or day camp delivery setting
- Valid First Aid & CPR certification must obtain prior to employment confirmation
- Knowledge of a wide variety of age-appropriate activities in the areas of sports, arts, culture, outdoor recreation and environmental studies
- Strong leadership, administration and planning skills
- Excellent problem solving, communication and interpersonal skills.
- Working effectively with children from diverse cultures, economic backgrounds, and special needs
- Experience in conflict resolution and handling inappropriate behaviour and challenging group dynamics
- Fluency in a second language is an asset
- Must be 19 years old prior to Jun 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

#### **Job Specifications:**

- Work with a team to plan and implement a wide range of day camp activities ie. crafts, sports, games
- Ensure the health and safety of all program participants, staff and volunteers
- Work with team to deliver a safe, fun, creative environment for day camp participants each day
- Build positive relationships with participants, parents, guardians, co-worker's and the community centre staff
- Provide feedback to parents, guardians and participants that foster self-confidence and positive social behaviors
- Provide a positive role model to participants and volunteers at all times
- Keep records that pertain to the administration of the camp i.e. attendance, participant waivers, sign-in/sign-out sheets, accident and incident reports, weekly program schedules.
- Participate in staff feedback meetings on a weekly basis

#### **Compensation & Schedule**

- \$21.00/hour + 4% vacation pay
- Monday–Friday, 35–40 hours/week (8–10 weeks, June–August)

#### **Required Availability**

- Training: June 13 (9am–5pm)
- Full camp: July 6–August 28

**Conditions for Consideration:** Hours per week and period of employment are dependent upon Canada Summer Jobs program funding. A cleared police information check is a requirement for this position.
